Foreword

The Gap State High School is offering families the opportunity to purchase a school managed device under the CYOD program. This Selection Guide provides specifications and configurations for the devices offered in the 2022-2023 round of Choose Your Own Device (CYOD) at The Gap State High School. To submit your expression of interest, please click on the “Expression of Interest” link on the CYOD page of the school website.

The 1-to-1 Technology Program (CYOD and BYOD) offered by The Gap SHS is explained in more detail in the *The Gap SHS CYOD/BYOD Handbook* which is available on the school website. This Selection Guide should be read in conjunction with the Handbook document. Participation in the Student 1-to-1 Technology Program (CYOD or BYOD) is conditional upon participation in the Student Resource Scheme.

Both 3 and 4 year warranty options are available.

Again, please refer to the The Gap SHS CYOD/BYOD Handbook for any points of clarity regarding support offerings, device ownership, software, etc.

Acceptance of this expression of interest is dependent on students being either a current student or being enrolled for 2023 at our school.

Timelines

The CYOD online order form will be open until 3rd March 2023.

As orders are submitted through the online form, invoices will be raised within 7 days. As soon as invoices have been paid, devices will be ordered from Acer.

We expect a four week turnaround from ordering the device to receiving it. This is subject to change and is not something that can be controlled as a school level.

It is highly recommended that students entering graphics/multimedia subjects select the Premium or Premium Plus option.

All CYOD laptops come with preinstalled and school managed internet filtering. The default filtering level selected is Medium which will permit access to social media and video sites such as Facebook and YouTube whilst at home. Should you wish to have social media and video sites blocked on the CYOD laptop while at home, please email cyod@thegapshs.eq.edu.au.

FAQs

Q: When will I be invoiced for my selected laptop?

A: Invoices will be issued within 7 days of an order submission

Q: Can I withdraw my expression of interest after the device has been paid?

A: Once an expression of interest has been paid for, we are committed to the order and as such we are unable to process a withdrawal. However, the device can be transitioned to a BYO and reset to factory settings.

Q: Can the school set use times for certain websites at home?

A: We are unable to set specific time frames for websites. It is highly recommended that families invest in a third-party internet filtering solution for their home devices while at home.

Q: Why can't the school state the final price of the device prior to invoicing?

A: Device prices available to the school are revised monthly. Factors such as supply chain, parts cost and demand influence the monthly prices. As such, we will only know the final price when devices are invoiced. Generally, final prices do not vary greatly.

Q: Can I make payment prior to the invoice being issued?

A: Payment cannot be made prior to invoices being issued.

Q: Are there any software restrictions on the laptop?

A: Yes. There are some programs that cannot be installed as they have been deemed unsafe for student use by Education Queensland. These include but are not limited to Steam, Discord and Bluestacks. This list may grow as we become aware of future programs.

Q. Can I purchase a device after the expression of interest close date?

A. Unfortunately not. We are unable to accept orders past the expression of interest close date.

Q. Can I install a different version of Windows on the laptop?

A. No. As the devices are still owned by the school, they must run the Education Queensland Windows operating system. Removing this operating will create accessibility issues with our network and in some cases, repairs being heavily delayed due to the inability to run diagnostics on the device. It may also prevent license activations for school software.

Q. What if I don't want the school to manage the device?

A. In this instance, the device would be reset and transferred to the family as a BYO device. The school will not be able to log any warranty or ADP claims for the device however you would be able to log them yourself with Acer directly.
