Online Subject Selection Registration

1. Access the OneSchool website at <http://oslp.eq.edu.au>
2. Log on with your EQ/MIS username and password
3. Navigate to the Subject Selection tab, click [here](#) then click the Radio Button () and 'Edit'
4. Select your subjects
5. Enter a third preference (**click – add new**)
6. Click **Save**

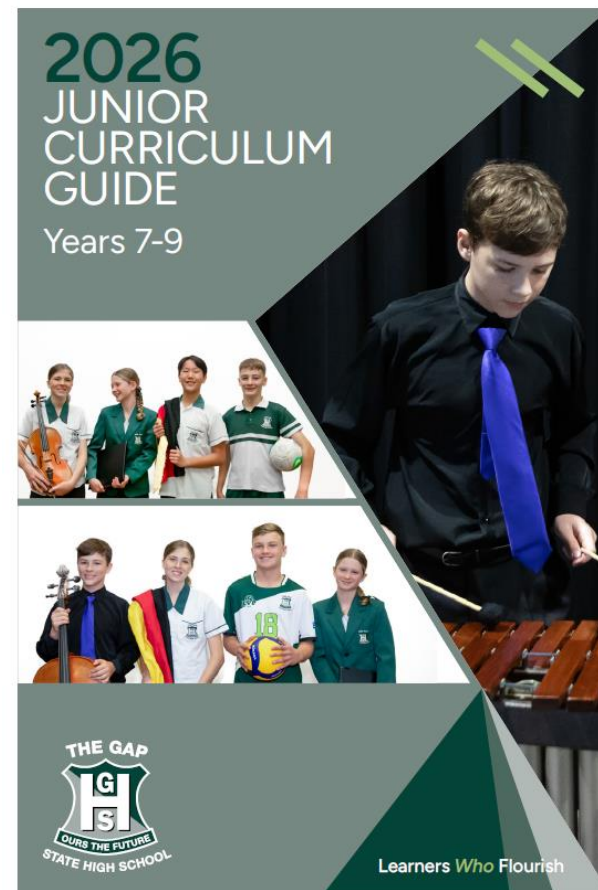

2. When the website loads the student will need to enter the following details. They are the same account details used to access the internet at school. a. Logon ID b. Password (This is your normal EQ/MIS username and password – ask class teacher to reset if required).

JCE Tracking – Ensuring Success

At the end of each reporting juncture, student results are analysed to ensure students are on track to achieve their JCE.

If a student is not on track to achieve their JCE, they will be contacted by a member of Pathways & Performance and may be required to complete a JET plan.

A JET plan includes a self-reflection for students to consider their progress, look for opportunities for growth and to set goals. The JET plan is then reviewed by the student's parents or carers and a relevant staff member from TGSHS
