

# Accelerated Music Program (AMPed)

The Gap State High School Accelerated Music Program (AMPed) is a high performing curriculum program for students who show ability, initiative and a strong commitment to music success both in the classroom and in instrumental/vocal music. The AMPed program has the requirement that students complete AMEB theory courses and participated in our Instrumental and/or Vocal Music Program as part of their classroom music studies. Students are accelerated through the Australian Curriculum – Music strand one year ahead of their cohort whilst participating in the Instrumental Music/Vocal Music program. N.B. Students do not need to apply for AMPed to be considered for the Instrumental/Vocal Music program. Selection into the program requires students to complete the following application:



When submitting Accelerated Music Program (AMPed) Applications please include the following documents:

- 1. Completed Application form
- 2. Photocopy of latest school report card
- 3. Endorsement from current instrumental/vocal teacher
- 4. Photocopies of any supporting documentation related to <u>music</u> studies pertinent to this application. This could include examination results, report card results, competition results etc.

## **Selection Process – AMPed**

All students applying for entry must undertake a short-written theory exam that will occur on the same day as their performance audition. This will consist of preliminary theory concepts – pitch (treble and bass clef note names); rhythms (note types and time signatures) and terms and signs – all of which students will have encountered in their performance repertoire. The practical audition will consist of scales, studies and set pieces that can be found on the school website. The results from this audition and test, application responses and referee statement will be considered when assessing applications. The testing and administration fee is \$90 for each excellence program application, unless the students is applying out of catchment.

Students may audition on any instrument supported by DET's Instrumental Music Program (Strings, Woodwind, Brass or Percussion). We encourage students to demonstrate their skills on these primary instruments first but also use their audition time to showcase any other instruments (including voice) that they play at a high level. Additionally, limited places exist for students of Piano, Guitar or Electric Bass as the Department of Education does not support a program for the instruction of these instruments. Students who have attained AMEB Grade 3 level instrument (or equivalent) on these instruments are encouraged to apply with the expectation that they participate in our Instrumental or Vocal Music program when invited.

Vocal students wishing to audition should be a member of their school choir and it is highly recommended that they are having vocal lessons.

Applications will be reviewed by the Accelerated Music Program (AMPed) Entry Panel. All decisions made by the Panel are final. **Note:** Should students not receive an offer in the first round of testing, this does not mean they are unsuccessful. Applications will be held over until the next round to be considered against other candidates.

The testing and administration fee is \$90. It is non-refundable and payable when you lodge your application. Outof-Catchment students will be required to pay an out-of-catchment fee of \$100 plus the application fee of \$90 (\$190 in total).

## Accelerated Music Program (AMPed) FAQs

### Can I submit an Honours application without enrolling my child?

• NO. Applications will not be considered unless a completed enrolment application is submitted. This includes providing all supporting documentation and payment of fees.

#### Can out of catchment students apply for the Honours program?

- YES. The Gap State High School has an Enrolment Management Plan. A limited number of places are available for students who live outside the catchment and, in the first instance, these places are reserved for students who qualify and are offered a place in Excellence Programs.
- Out of catchment enrolments applying for AMPed must first submit an Application for Enrolment to be considered for wait listing, prior to progressing through the AMPed Selection Process.

#### Can we apply for more than one Excellence Program?

- YES. Students may apply for both Academic Honours and Accelerated Music Program or Academic Honours and Elite Volleyball Program. Students are unable to accept a position in both the Accelerated Music Program, the Elite Volleyball Program or Honours German Immersion.
- Students applying for more than one program (Academic Honours, Elite Volleyball Program (EVP) and AMPed) must indicate this on their application. Students are not able to participate in EVP and AMPed concurrently, but MAY be accepted into both Honours and AMPed if successful for 2024.

#### Will my child have access to all specialist/elective lessons?

• NO. Students successful in obtaining places in the AMPed Program are advised that due to the requirement to complete AMEB theory studies access to other Arts subjects (Visual Art, Drama and Media Arts) in the timetable may be restricted in Years 7 and 8.

#### Does acceptance into AMPed guarantee a place for the length of the program?

- Students must maintain high academic standards in all subjects (A/B) to retain their place in the program.
- Should an out of catchment student wish to withdraw from an Excellence program, the principal may cancel the student's enrolment.

#### What options are there for my child if they are unsuccessful in applying for AMPed?

- Accelerated Music runs in parallel with our Instrumental Music Program. Students who are unsuccessful in their application for AMPed will be automatically accepted into the Instrumental and/or Vocal Music Program unless their audition indicates they are at beginner level.
- Enrolment in the Accelerated Music class is not required to participate in Instrumental Music at The Gap State High School.
