The Gap State High School Entrance



This building is at the front of the school.
 You are entering from Gate 2. It can be loud here as there is lots of passing traffic on Waterworks Rd.



- As you walk down the steps from the main entrance you are entering the school quad.
- This is where students play handball, eat their lunch or meet to socialise. It can be noisy at break times as people talk and play.
- There are shelters here that students can sit under for shade.
- You will also find C and D Block classrooms here and the Tuckshop and Uniform shop.

Year 7 E Block







- This building is E Block where you will have most of your classes.
- You enter E Block by walking up the ramp.

- There are several classrooms on each level of E block. Each classroom is numbered next to the door.
- You put your bag in the rack before you enter the class and get out the things you will need.
- You will line up with your classmates and wait for the teacher to let you in.
- The classrooms are all air conditioned so they don't get to hot in summer.
- There are also ceiling fans in the classroom that can also be used in hot weather.
- E block is also where the Year 7 teacher staffroom is. You can knock on the door and ask for your teachers. They are happy to help you.

JA Robertson Hall









- This is at the top entrance (Gate 3) to the Admin Building. This gate is the closest to the library building and JA Hall.
- You will follow the path through the gardens and under the gazebo. You will hear traffic from the road and maybe birdsongs.
- You will see two buildings in the background.
 The grey building is M block where Drama and Music classes are held. The brown brick building is JA Hall where Orientation and other school events are held.
- You enter JA Hall through the automatic doors at the front of the building.
- Inside the building it is carpeted with ceiling fans for when it gets hot.

Student Support Services



• Student Support Services is located underneath E Block in E Lower. You will walk down the stairs next to the entrance the E Block.









- You walk across the concrete and over the wooden floor to enter the building.
- You will find the Guidance Officers here if you need to talk to them.
- You can come here if you have a case manager but cannot find them. The teacher aide in charge will call them to see if they are available.
- E Lower is also where you might come if you need some quiet time to refocus before returning to class.
- The classrooms are carpeted with air conditioning when it is hot. They have a range of seats that you can use if you need to as well as a beanbag.
- There is also a classroom in E Lower which is where you might come to do further work to improve your literacy or numeracy skills.


The Leadership Training Centre (LTC)

Library



• The library is near JA Hall. There is a seating area outside the library.
