Significant achievements/contribution to society: Edith Cowan was an Australian social reformer who championed to improve the lives of women children, and anyone in need.

Cowan was known in parliament for her refusal to consistently vote/align with her party. She is also known for two bills; the rights of women to vote, and inheritance rights for women.
