The Gap State High School will receive

\$345,120

This funding will be used to:

- Attain consistent levels of achievement across all school subjects so that As + Bs = 67%
- Attain an increase in students' writing skills, particularly in Year 9 NAPLAN > 600
- Attain a continuing increase in numeracy, particularly in Year 9 NAPLAN > 620
- Increase the Year 9 NAPLAN upper two bands (U2B) scores for Writing and Numeracy to 35%
- Support targeted students to attain their academic potential in literacy and numeracy

Our initiatives include:

- Improve the quality of classroom teaching in all classrooms by professional development, peer coaching and mentoring
- Ensure all teachers are proficient in the use of classroom data placemats to record and action differentiated teaching strategies for groups of students or individual students
- Create a more collaborative culture for annual performance reviews that supports continual professional improvement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Employing experienced educators to support teachers and groups of students to improve literacy and numeracy attainment \$120,120
- Supplying additional teacher aide time to support intervention strategies for students requiring additional learning assistance \$45,000
- Employing specialist teachers to extend and provide enrichment activities for students \$120,000
- Provide professional development sessions for improving pedagogical practices \$60,000
