What is the A4A program? The A4A program is a parent-driven initiative which aims to enable new and diverse activities for students. It does this by parents hosting fun activities for other parents, students and the community in order to raise funds. The aim is to support new and varied experiences for GSHS students. The program taps into the skills and interests of the community to support engagement, entrepreneurial leadership, creativity, innovation, and wellbeing. Watch the [video](#). How does it work? In brief, parents (or others) volunteer to run “activities” for parents, and/or children/staff. Activities can be run anywhere, including at school. A small per-person fee is paid by participants. The activities are as diverse as human interests: DIY gift-making, wood-fired pizza, gardening, bicycle maintenance, yoga, cricket, soccer game, programming for kids, pottery, photography, i-phone skills, treasure hunts are all possible.

How is money raised? Costs are covered by the activity. Sometimes school resources/facilities enable the activity. Sometimes local business may support activities. A good example is the Gap Ninja Warrior 2017 night where 60 participants raised over \$700, with support from Moon Lee Tae Kwon-Do and Ritual HQ Gym Watch the [video](#). The P&C approve activities, arrange insurance, support bookings, disburse collected monies, and report annually.

Short description and cost	Have you ever used a drawknife, side axe, froe, or spokeshave? Work with and learn from craftsman Bruce Teakle in a day of hand tool woodwork using local timber. Set in a beautiful rainforest workshop, you will return home with new insight and at least one finished product (eg a bench hook, or cutting board). You will also be given a taste of traditional blacksmithing with scrap steel and home-made charcoal. Tools and materials will be supplied. Filmmakers whose movies get accepted into the festival also get valuable press attention and exposure to external Social Media sources such as TGSHS face book, You Tube and third party websites. Prizes shall be offered to best films of the evening. This event will be open to students of The Gap State High School and the wider community within The Gap. The film submission - categories are based on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documentary about “The Gap”; • Promotional Video local business; • Open Genre - Action, adventure, drama, romance, comedy, suspense, and westerns; and • Animation/ Music. <p><u>All material must be original footage including music scores etc.</u></p> <p>Eligibility: Each film must comply to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum run time 4 minutes in length inclusive credits; • No Minimum run time; • All films must be rated PG (mild in impact)* – No swearing/blood/ gore limited-no nudity <p>*The impact of PG (Parental Guidance) classified films and should be no higher than mild, but they may contain content that children find confusing or upsetting and may require the guidance of parents and guardians. They may, for example, contain classifiable elements such as language and themes that are mild in impact.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short films eligibility/ Participation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Adult Shorts – director aged 18 years or older. ○ Student Shorts – director in 13-17 ○ Junior Shorts – director aged 12 years or younger. ○ Films should have been completed in 2017 or 2018. ○ Films should be under 4 minutes in duration. ○ Filmmakers must be resident within The Gap • All non-English language films should have English subtitles. • All rights, permissions and clearances must be obtained prior to submission in accordance with Australian copyright laws (guidance notes with entry form):
