Expectation

1 Year 5 & 6

- HPE Australian Curriculum

- Participate in Primary Schools Cup for possible selection

2 Year 7 & 8

- Apply, trial and join EVP
- Aspire to recruit athletes for two Year 7 and two Year 8 EVP classes
- HPE lessons with focus on the Australian Curriculum
- Students are together for HPE class only
- Leadership: Rotating leadership roles to develop well rounded athletes

3 Year 9

- Continue in EVP + HPE classes
- HPE lessons with focus on the Australian Curriculum
- Leadership: Rotating leadership roles to develop well rounded athletes

4 Year 10

- Continue in EVP
- Commence QCAA senior Applied subject, Sport & Recreation (complete Unit 1)
- Students are together for Sport and Recreation subject only
- Leadership: Nominate and apply for team leadership

5 Year 11 & 12

- Continue in Sport & Recreation
- Complete Unit 2, 3 and 4 for QCAA Sport and Recreation. Remain ATAR eligible
- Students are together for Sport and Recreation class only
- Leadership: Nominate and apply for team leadership
